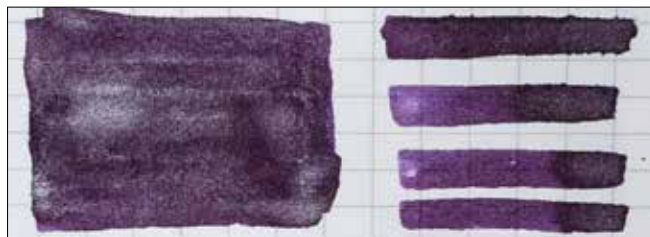
"1798" Silver sheen ink
